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Dear Parents,

Firstly, we want to thank you for choosing PaRK International School for the next school year for your child(ren) – we will work to exceed all your expectations!

**Please read carefully all points (10) of this circular.**

### 1. START OF THE YEAR

To better start the year and to give children the opportunity to get to know the school and the teachers in the best way (especially new students) we will have different starting days:

- Early Learning (1 - 5 Year Olds)

All children who attended the school in the 2021-22 academic year will start classes on September 5. New students will begin classes between September 6 and 7:

- 1 & 2 Year Olds and 18 Months: New students with names beginning with the letters A through L will start school on September 6; children with names beginning with the letters from M to Z will start school on September 7. All children start on September 8 (students attending school on the 6<sup>th</sup> will not attend school on the 7<sup>th</sup>).
- 3 Year Olds: Former students will start the school year on September 5 and new students on September 6.
- 4 Year Olds: Former students will start the school year on September 5 and new students on September 6.
- 5 Year Olds: Former students will start the school year on September 5 and new students on September 6.
- Junior School (Grade 1-4)
  - Grade 1: All students will begin classes on September 5. On the first day of school, parents are invited to start the day with them at 8:45 am to meet the teacher and the other students.
  - Grade 2: All students will begin classes on September 6.
  - Grade 3: All students will begin classes on September 6.
  - Grade 4: All students will begin classes on September 6.

- **Early Learning School - 4 and 5 Year Olds**
  - o Change of clothes properly identified (school uniform obligatory)
  - o Storage Box for the change of clothes (suggestion: [IKEA box](#))
  - o Reusable Water Bottle
  - o Hat (school uniform)
- **Junior School (Grades 1-4)**
  - o All school materials (please refer to point 9 on this document) must be properly identified. The books will be delivered in the first week of school along with the Mandatory Pack.
  - o Reusable Water Bottle

PaRK International School reserves the right not to accept, on the first day of school, a child that has not delivered the required documents.

#### 4. EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

There are a number of extracurricular activities (subject to a minimum and a maximum number of children enrolled) available after school hours. All activities have limited vacancies which will be given in order of enrolment.

The description, prices, schedules and extracurricular activities enrolment form will be sent by email no later than August 12<sup>th</sup> and parents have until September 15<sup>th</sup> to enrol their child.

PaRK International School is closed on public holidays, Lisbon's official holiday (June 13<sup>th</sup>) and the following days:

June 9<sup>th</sup> will be non-academic for Early Learning School and Junior School Students: students attending school will have activities organised.

#### 7. SCHEDULES

The school schedule is from 8 am to 6 pm. From this time to 7 pm it is considered an extension period. During August the school is open from 8:30 am to 6 pm.

It is essential that children be punctual so that they have a successful school life.

- Arriving at school: Children must arrive no later than their specific entry time – activities will begin at this time and it is important that children are present from the beginning. Children are in school activities outlined by the educational programme from:
  - Early Learning (1-5 Year Olds):
    - 1-2 Year Olds: 9:30 am to 4:30 pm
    - 3-5 Year Olds: 9:00 am to 4:30 pm
  - Junior School (Grades 1-4): 8:30 am to 4:00 pm

- Exiting school: please respect the schedule chosen at the beginning of the year (with or without extension) thus it is the only way we can guarantee the safety of all students – the number of adults who remain at extension follows a ratio that depends on the number of children present. If there is the need for a student to leave before, the school should be notified.

## 8. UNIFORMS

Uniform orders should be placed using the [online platform](#). The uniform invoices are sent by email when the purchases are ready to be collected and charged by direct debit.

Please note that uniforms are mandatory for all students. The uniform is important and should always be respected by students. All uniform items must be in good condition and of an appropriate size to guarantee students are well presented.
