NOTES:

- For **Senior School students** (Grades 6-12) the school is closed during school breaks.
- June 09 will be non-academic:** Early Learning School and Junior School Students attending school will have activities organised.
- For **Early Learning** and **Junior School** (1 Year Olds - Grade 5) the school is closed during one of the Spring Break weeks and from July 28th to August 8th. During these weeks the school will operate as Holiday / Summer Camps, offering alternatives for these students, with activities specifically designed for each age group. These activities will be provided by different teams, and will have an associated cost.
- Grade 9** calendar includes a two-week 'Exam Study Leave' by late May / early June – during this period, students only attend school for the exams themselves. Once the Exam Study Leave ends, students return to school on regular hours until the end of the school year.
- Grade 10 & Grade 12** calendar includes an 'Exam Study Leave' that usually starts in late April (dates depend on the external IGCSE, AS Levels, A Levels and IB exam timetable for each specific year). From then on students only attend school for the exams themselves, and for any other specific events (such as the Grade 10 IB/A Level induction days or the end of year award ceremony).

NOTES:

- Registration/Enrolment Renewal

New students' registration fee is due at the time of acceptance. Payment can be made by bank transfer, cheque or tickets. Current student enrolment renewal fee is charged in April by direct debit.

- Tuition and payment options

Registration/renewal implies the payment of the annual tuition.

The annual fee can be paid:

- Per term, in September, December and April (by direct debit and/or tickets)
- In full, during September (by bank transfer and/or tickets)
- 10 instalments September to June (by direct debit and/or tickets)
- 12 instalments September to August (by direct debit and/or tickets) (must seek approval from head of Finance with justifiable request)

- Sibling Discount

Families with three or more children enrolled benefit from a 10% discount on the annual tuition applicable to the third youngest child onwards.

INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL FEE:

- Meals

The mid-morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack are included in the tuition for Early Learning School students (1-5 Year Olds) and Junior School students (Grades 1-5).

- Notebooks, textbooks and guided reading books

All notebooks, manuals and school books will be provided by the school. At the end of the school year, students must return the manuals and school books in good condition, showing only the normal wear expected for a year. In the case of books being written, or they wear beyond the expected, its value will be charged to the student, at the end of the school year. If there is a need to replace a book due to damage or loss, it will be charged, but it will still be owned by PaRK IS.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL FEE:

- Meals

From Grade 6 students may choose to have food supplied by:

- The school (lunch: soup, choice of main and fruit) - €135/month
- Home (lunch must come preheated in a thermos and bring cutlery)
- School Bar

The food options can be changed by informing the school by the 20th of the previous month.

- Devices

PaRK IS has a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Programme starting in Grade 4: students from Grade 4 to Grade 5 must have a personal iPad; students from Grade 6 to Grade 12 must have a personal laptop.

- Extension Period

Parents/Guardian may opt for the extension period, from 6:00 pm to 6:30 pm. For 1 Year Olds to Grade 5 this period is supervised with a cost of 65€ per month. From Grade 6 the school offers spaces with limited supervision where students can stay during the extension period. without any cost.

- Transport (Restelo >> Alfragide)

PaRK IS has a transport service between Restelo and Alfragide campuses, in the morning and in the afternoon, in order to facilitate the logistics of families with children in both locations.

Schedule:

- 8 am: departure from the Restelo campus to the Alfragide campus
- 4:30 pm: departure from the Alfragide campus to the Restelo campus

This service will have the following conditions¹:

- Monthly cost of € 12 (1x per day) or € 17 (2x per day)
- Service available from September to June, inclusive, with the exception of winter and spring school breaks - in these months the cost will be discounted by 50%
- Service assigned by order of enrollment (students who choose 2 daily trips have priority)
- Service subject to a minimum of 15 students per bus / journey
- This service covers the week from Monday to Friday - it is not possible to enrol students for this service only for a few days a week
- Service cancellation can only be carried out at the end of each period.

- Other charges **not included** in the annual tuition

- Uniform (official, sports and everyday)
- Diapers
- Individual school supplies
- School Outing (22€ each)²
- Extension Period (6:00 pm - 6:30 pm)
- IGCSE Exams (Grade 10)
- AS Levels (Grade 11)
- IB Exams / A Level (Grade 12)
- Annual Photos (optional)
- School Trips (optional)
- Extracurricular activities (optional)
- Academic Support (including the English Language Development Programme from Grade 5 to Grade 8)
- Psycho-pedagogical Support

6. OTHER INFORMATION

- We may require both parents' approval to accept the registration.
- We only accept pre-registration for the current and the next school year.
- The child's school year is determined by his/her birth date, the cut-off date being the 15th of September.
- The payment of the registration/renewal represents a commitment of frequency for the entire school year to which it relates and is non-refundable.

7. NEW STUDENTS ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Expression of interest to know the school/educational project

The information request can be done [online](#). We will need the child's name and date of birth.

2. Pre-Registration

Following the information request, parents will be asked to fill out a form on the Admissions portal. Candidates are placed on the waiting list by date of application and can proceed to schedule a visit. Siblings of current and former students have priority in admission. Applications are accepted from October of the preceding year of entrance and are only valid for the following school year. Although students typically join PaRK International School at the beginning of the school year, admissions are accepted and welcomed throughout the year. In case of vacancy and the student being admitted, he/she can start school in the middle of the year, after following the normal process of enrolment.

3. School Visit

Visits to the school are scheduled by the families during the process, also in the Admissions portal, on the most convenient date and time. We advise families to visit the school. If this is not possible, you can schedule an online meeting.

4. Confirmation of Interest

If you are interested in continuing the process, a Candidate fee of 80€ is required (non-refundable).

5. Interview (Junior Schools onwards)

From Grade 1, an interview with the future student is part of the admission process and will be scheduled after the first visit of the Parent/Guardian to the school. It may still be necessary to have a specific assessment for some discipline(s), if the Section Head deems important to have additional information. From Grade 5 students will be subjected to an online cognitive test and, if necessary, to an interview.

6. Acceptance

The child's admission is determined by the School Board with the advice of the Section Head. The decision is communicated by email to the parents along with the necessary steps to complete the enrollment. If necessary, PaRK IS can request a "Clearance Letter" to the Parent/Guardian, which must be requested by them to the student's current school. By enrolling a student in PaRK International School, Parent/Guardian agree to comply with the information stated in this document.

7. Formal Registration

The official registration takes place, in person, in June. At that time, the Parent/Guardian must deliver the necessary documents to the student's process, including PaRK International School Terms & Conditions signed.
